

ICES/ICE Mutual Exemption Agreement

The Institution of Civil Engineers (ICE) welcomes applications for membership from Members and Fellows of the Chartered Institution Civil Engineering Surveyors (ICES). Applicants must have been an ICES member (MCInstCES) for more than 2 years and have worked in the built environment for more than 12 years (advisory minimum). ICES Fellows are also eligible to apply for Fellowship of the ICE. Full details are available on the ICE website www.ice.org.uk

Membership principles



ICES members interested in applying, please submit the following documents:

- Membership application form - 2 copies
- A detailed CV - see the ICE Membership Guidance Note 15 - 2 copies
- A certified* copy of your academic qualifications - 3 copies
- A certified* copy of your ICES membership certificate - 3 copies
- A record of your continuing professional development (CPD) showing at least 5 days of CPD per year over the last 5 years - 2 copies
- Sponsors questionnaire* - 2 copies
- An application fee (cheque or credit card payment made payable to Institution of Civil Engineers)

*Certified copies must be 'true copies of the original' which are signed and dated by a senior member of your employing company, a corporate member of ICE or one of your sponsors.

Sponsor Requirements

All applications for membership must be supported by at least 3 sponsors (2xICE and 1xICES) who must be current Members or Fellows of at least 3 years standing. The sponsor must also be of the same grade or above that for which the applicant is applying.

Timescale

Applications are considered by the Exemption and Recognition Panel. The panel normally meets four times a year. You will be advised of the outcome within four weeks of the panel meeting. Members and Fellows interested in the scheme should consult the ICE website www.ice.org.uk and apply directly.
