CONDITIONS OF USE

- 1) The Institution crest is available for reproduction on company letterheads, stationery literature and signboards. The sizes and colours used for such reproduction must be strictly in accordance with that stated on the crest specification sheet and the conditions of use.
- 2) The crest is available for use within the following business entities:
 - (i) The member or entity carries suitable and appropriate professional indemnity insurance at all times.
 - (ii) Members trading as sole proprietors of a business.
- 3) Having been granted a licence to use the crest in the manner applied for, an applicant is at liberty to seek further extensions to such licence by way of subsequent submissions for approval at no additional charge.
- 4) Any willful breach of these conditions of use by a member or by members employed by a company or organisation using the crest may render the individual or individuals concerned liable to disciplinary action and possible expulsion from the institution.
- 5) Any decision by the Institution not to grant approval for the use of the crest shall be final.
- 6) Throughout the term of the licence the crest will remain the outright copyright of the institution.
- 7) The crest may be withdrawn at any time by the institution.
- 8) The crest must be used in conjunction with the ICES design standards.
