

Education, Professional Development and Membership Committee Chief Examiner

The Education, Professional Development and Membership Committee is seeking a chief examiner.

The chief examiner is a key role within the CICES professional development structure which is carried out on a voluntary basis for a minimum term of three years. The role is outward facing and requires a mix of remote and face to face activity. Commitment required to the role is typically half a day to a day per month which can vary according to business needs.

The successful candidate will support the development of competencies and examination processes that meet the continued needs of education and employers and ensure appropriate standards are maintained.

Knowledge of apprenticeship processes is desirable, as a key part of the role will be to work with the CICES team to successfully embed the new EngTech qualification alongside the more traditional development routes. As registration is a key part of the examinations process, applicants must be chartered with an institution recognised by Engineering Council UK.
