

# Quick Guide to...



## Engineering Technician (EngTech)

### Benefits

This is a designation that is recognised around the world and can be achieved by those in the full range of engineering disciplines.

### Eligibility

Any CICES Technical Member, Member or Fellow who has suitable experience to meet the required Engineering Council competencies of an Engineering Technician.

### How to Apply

- Download the guidebook to registration as an Engineering Technician from the CICES website (cices.org) to see what is entailed in making an application.
- Download the UK-SPEC document (Engineering Council website engc.org.uk). The assessment is made against the Engineering Technician specification.
- Complete the expression of interest form from the CICES website and submit it.
- The Membership Department (acting as Engineering Council registration qualifications manager) will advise on next steps; making a formal application, payment of fees and allocation of a mentor, and will answer questions about the process).

### What is Involved?

There are a number of documents to produce for assessment.

- Application form.
- Application fee.
- Completed Engineering Council competence and commitment statements (approx 1,500 words).
- Two page CV.
- Three years of CPD records.
- Experience report (approx. 2,000 words).
- Two Sponsors' questionnaires.

These will then be assessed for completeness and put forward for the review interview.

### Professional Review:

- Review against the UK-SPEC competencies.
- The Professional Review Interview lasts for up to 30 minutes and will include your 5 minute presentation. An additional 5 to 10 minutes will be required if you do not have the benchmark educational base for Engineering Technician. This will focus on science engineering and maths elements of the Engineering Council competencies A and B.

### The Outcome

- The award will be made (if successful) by the Engineering Council once the documentation has been scrutinised and cleared.
- The outcome is either successful or not. There are no deferrals or referrals or other grade offered. However, you can resit the Professional Review.
